Chi-Town Classic Side Pots

Brackets - \$5

Eight bowlers per bracket are paired randomly and compete head-to-head in a single-elimination format, with the winner of each match advancing to the next round until a champion is crowned.

The winner of each bracket takes home \$25; the runner-up wins \$10.

There will be scratch and handicap brackets. Everyone competes in the same scratch pool (there are no divisions).

Multiple quantities available at registration.

Megabrackets - \$10

This is a 64-bowler/six game bracket that takes place during the Team/Doubles and Doubles/Singles events. As with regular brackets, participating bowlers are randomly paired and face off against their opponents with the winner advancing to the next round until there is one champion.

Winner takes \$240. Second place takes \$100. Third and fourth place take \$20 each.

There will be scratch and handicap brackets. Everyone competes in the same scratch pool (there are no divisions).

Assignments of your specific brackets will be handled at registration.

Multiple quantities available at registration.

Mystery Pot - \$20

Entrants are eligible for a new pot each event (Singles, Doubles, and Team). Bowlers will use their scores from only the first and second games of each event (not the third game).

The winning score will be determined by the last two digits of the score. As an example, if the number "50" is drawn, then anyone bowling a 50, 150, or 250 is a winner.

The winning score will be called during the third game of each event.

Winner must be present to claim the cash prize.

Multiple winners during an event will split the prize fund allocated to that event.

Optional Scratch - \$20

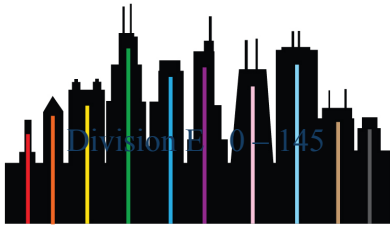
This event shall use the scratch scores from the nine tournament games to determine winners. There will be five divisions as follows:

Division A 206 and above

Division B 186 – 205

Division C 166 – 185

Division D 146 – 165



CHI-TOWN CLASSIC BOWLING TOURNAMENT

Dark Horse Doubles - \$10

In this event, bowlers will not know who their doubles partner is until the tournament is completed. Scores and handicap from the bowlers who have been randomly paired together will be used to determine the winners. Scores taken only from the three games of the Doubles event.

Multiple quantities available at registration.

Payment based on a 1:8 ratio.

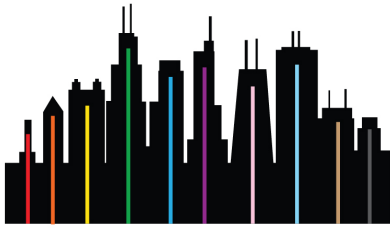
Eliminator - \$10

In the Eliminator, the event follows the order of the tournament (team, doubles, singles) and uses handicap scores. After each game, the bottom half of the alive field will receive an X. A bowler is eliminated from the field after 3 Xs. All bowlers making it to game 9 without 3 Xs are guaranteed to cash. First place wins \$300 based on 100 bowlers entering; prize amounts vary depending on the number of entries.

Senior Handicap - \$20

A separate handicap event that is open to bowlers aged 55 and older. Total score taken from singles, doubles, and team events.

Payment based on a 1:8 ratio.

Scratch Masters

Scratch Masters qualification is based on total scratch pinfall accumulated across Singles, Doubles, and Team events. The top six bowlers in each division qualify. If one or more of the top six cannot compete, the next highest bowler will replace them. In the event of a tie for sixth place, the bowler with the highest series (and, if still tied, the highest single-game score) will qualify.

Format: Low Bowlers Out

Six bowlers from each division will compete on the pair assigned to that division. After the first game, the two bowlers with the lowest scores are eliminated and the top four advance to Round 2. After Round 2, the bottom two are again eliminated, leaving the top two to face off head-to-head. The higher score in the final match wins the division. In the event of a tie, a three-frame roll-off will determine the winner.
